Basic Book Repair Workshop with Kevin Driedger October 15, 2009

This workshop will teach participants how to perform simple and effective repairs on books in their general collection. Participants will learn to assess the nature of the damage, decide on an appropriate treatment, and carry out several repair techniques. This workshop does not teach techniques for repairing materials that are special or rare.

Kevin Driedger works at the Library of Michigan in conservation and cataloging. He has been repairing books for more than ten years and leading book repair workshops for five years.

1) Each participant must have a small tool kit which is necessary to complete the workshop repairs. The kits can be purchased from Talas www.talasonline.com, part #TTB149001.

The tool kit is NOT provided by the presenter or the organizer of the workshop.

2) In addition, each participant should bring a pair of scissors, a ruler, and 3 books (2 hard-cover and 1 paperback) that are in reasonably good condition and can be damaged, or left with the instructor. These should not be books from the library's collection.
